### **Precautionary Statements**

Prevention: Keep away from heat, sparks, open flames, hot surfaces - no smoking. Keep container tightly

closed. No release into water. Use explosion-proof equipment. Use non-sparking tools. Take action to prevent static discharges. Avoid breathing vapors, mist, or spray. Wash affected area thoroughly after handling. Use only outdoors or in a well-ventilated area. Wear protective

gloves, eye protection, and face protection.

Response: IF SWALLOWED: Immediately call a physician or poison control center. If on skin (or hair):

### 4. FIRST AID MEASURES

**Inhalation:** Move to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration. If breathing is

difficult, give oxygen. Get immediate medical attention.

Skin contact: Remove contaminated clothing and footwear. Immediately flush skin with

plenty of water (using soap, if available). Get medical attention. Wash clothing

before reuse.

Eye contact: Rinse immediately with plenty of water, also under the eyelids, for at least 15

# 5. FIRE FIGHTING MEASURES

# 6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES
